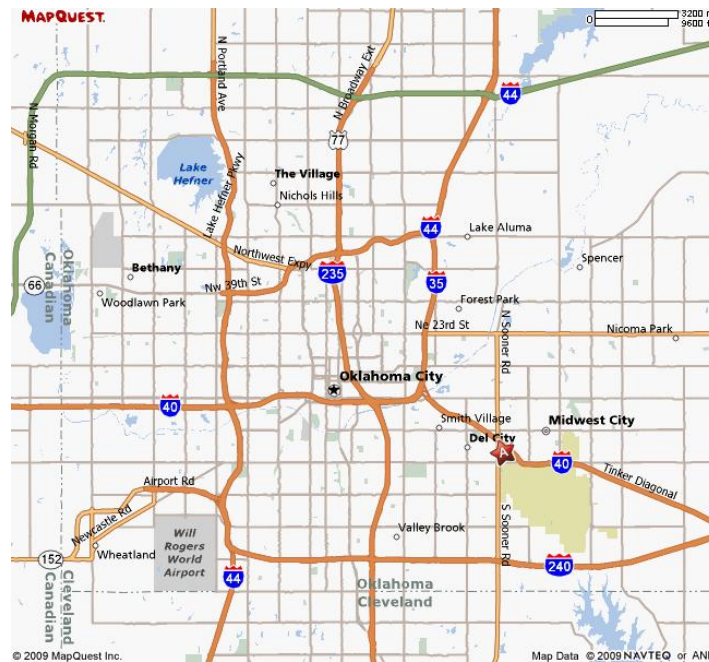

From North:

From I-35 S, continue toward OK City. Merge onto I-40 toward FT. SMITH, Exit 121B. Continue East via I-40, take the Sooner Road Exit 156A. Turn right onto Sooner Road, then turn left onto Liberty Pkwy. DRC is in Suite 700 on the north east corner of Building #1.

From South:

From I-35 N, merge onto I-240 E toward Shawnee. Take the Sooner Road, Exit 8. Turn left onto Sooner Rd. Continue North on Sooner Rd until past S.E. 29th St, then turn right onto Liberty Pkwy. DRC is in Suite 700 on the north east corner of Building #1.

From East:

From I-40 W take the Sooner Road Exit 156A. Turn left onto Sooner Road., turn left onto Liberty Pkwy. DRC is in Suite 700 on the north east corner of Building #1.

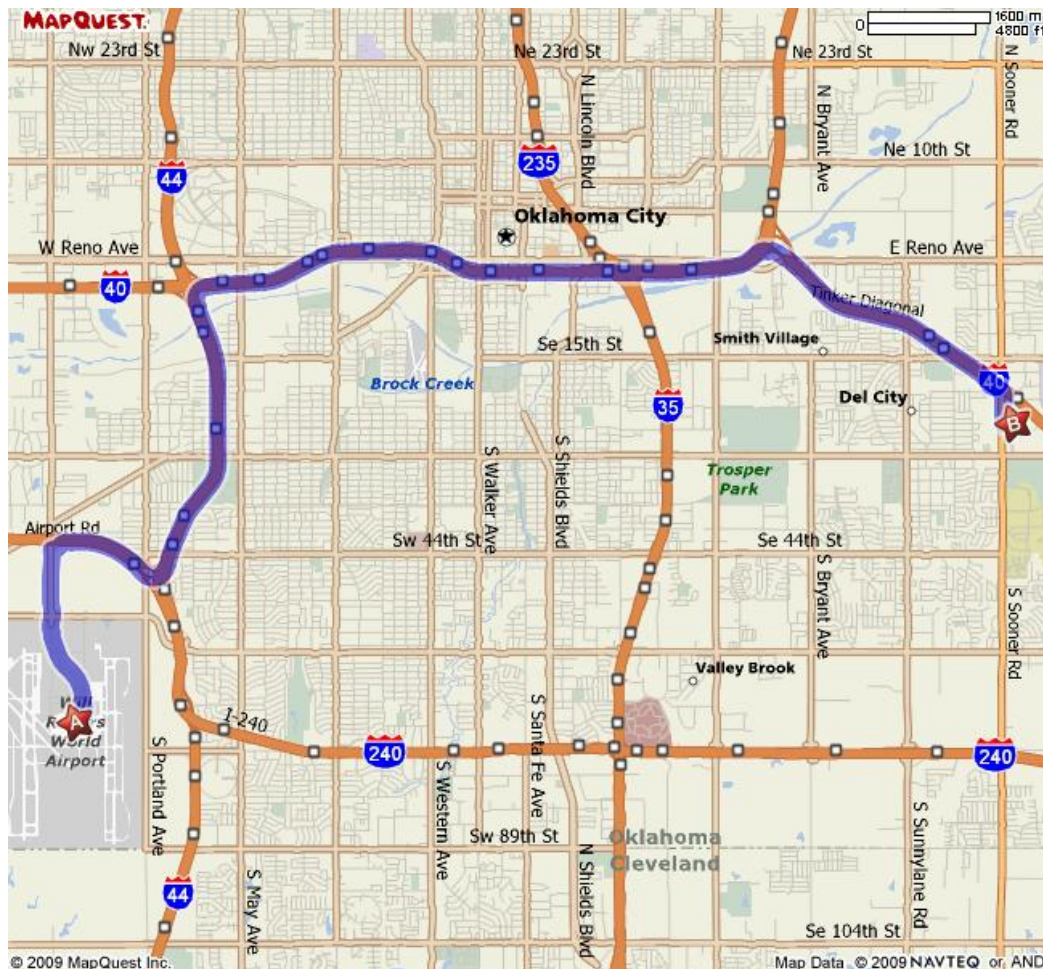

Go South on Terminal Drive. Go straight toward baggage claim. Continue straight on Terminal Drive until it becomes S. Meridian Ave. Take the ramp toward I-44/Downtown. Merge onto Airport Road. Merge onto I-44 E/OK-3 W/OK-74 N via the exit on the left toward Tulsa/Downtown. Merge onto I-40 E/US-270 E via Exit 120B toward Ft. Smith. Take the Sooner Road. Exit 156A -. Merge onto S., turn left onto Liberty Pkwy. DRC suite is on the north east corner of the Building #1.

The Oklahoma City National Memorial & Museum was created to honor "those who were killed, those who survived and those changed forever" by the 1995 bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City. The Memorial and Museum are dedicated to educating visitors about the impact of violence, informing about events surrounding the bombing, and inspiring hope and healing through lessons learned by those affected. The Outdoor Symbolic Memorial includes the Field of Empty Chairs with each chair honoring one of the 168 people who were killed, the monumental bronze-clad Gates of Time, a shallow 318 foot long reflecting pool, the promontory and Survivor Tree, Rescuers Orchard, and a special area for children.
